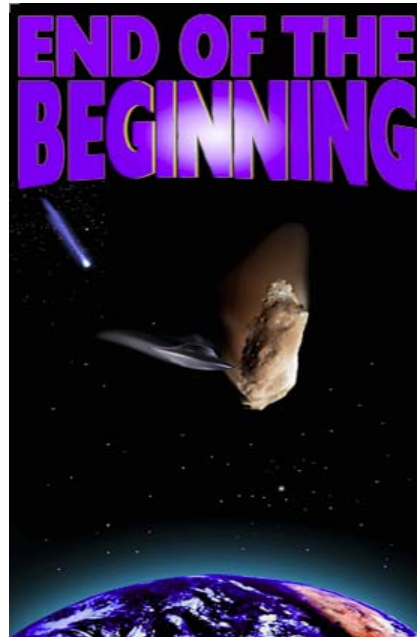

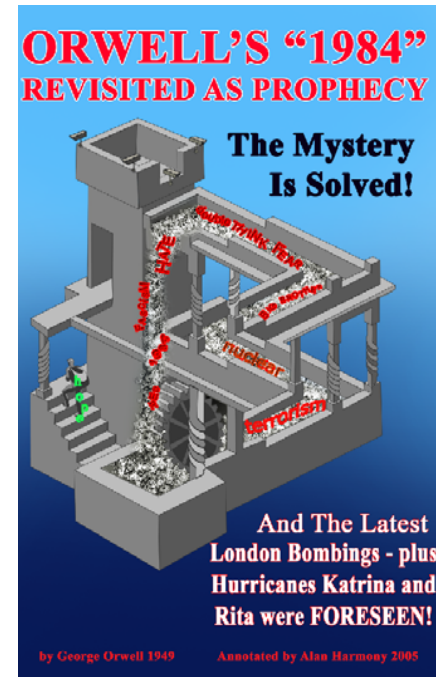
3. The End of the Beginning

4. Orwell's '1984' Revisited



How can Big Brother conduct illegal activities right under the 'nose of the law'? It controls the law. '1984' was an alarming, runaway best seller from 1949. Yet it's an unfulfilled prophecy. The main province of Orwell's Oceania had a population of 300 million. In October 2006 the USA reached that

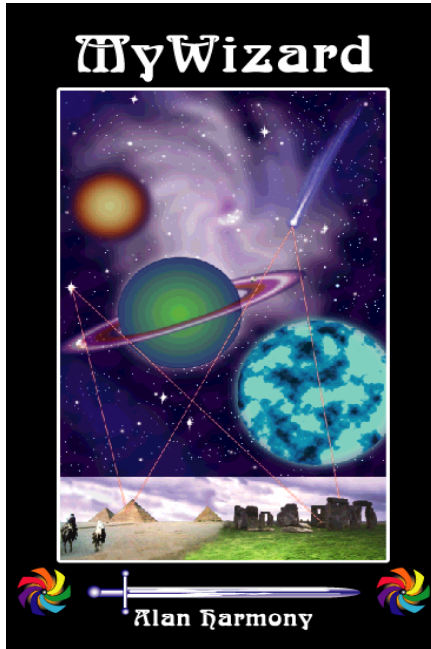
number, coincidence? No other country has had that population during the time Orwell's book has been in print either. Several more major coincidences emerge. It cites New York's 2001 '911' event, as Big Brother's work, to ready you for scriptural prophecies revealing Big Brother later.

This book contains the entire text of Orwell's "1984", adding an annotation of the dream-based portions, to show a future nuclear war, started by 'foreigners' living in 'Airstrip One', England.

A time-limited opportunity exists to protect against, or preempt, terrorists with nukes and against the biggest enemy of peace, Big Brother. There's no need to panic or leave either concern to law enforcement agencies that 'slip up' or work for Big Brother's 'machine'. We have the ability to act in our own defence, but first you need more facts about what, who, when and how. 450 pages, color images, black ink for original text, blue for the annotations.

5. My Wizard

A book written for wizards-to-be. A tribute to the author's mother: written for children to enjoy. Young wizards take the second, prophetic part of this book in stride far easier than adults. Children will be a big factor in solving foreseen problems revealed in prophecies. They are not burdened by limits to the future or thinking that adults accept.



Readers go on a tour of the making of a wizard. Then go to 'events & happenings' of our time. Some are real eye-openers, a few unknown in scriptural sources. For the older set, it adds a healthful way to overcome Alzheimer's.

My Wizard is filled with foreseen

near-future events; events include disasters, a five year long global drought and famine that we have five years to prepare for plus sundry upheavals, including tsunamis that make the one on Boxing Day, 2004 and earthquake in Haiti in 2010 look small. None of this is meaningful unless we act preemptively. The series shows how. 240 pages, blue for the annotated sections. Color images.

An abridged version, **'First School of Spells'**, gives early school grades of wizards-to-be a word 'game' and a 'spell' to make the world a better place. 6. 1 Enoch Explained



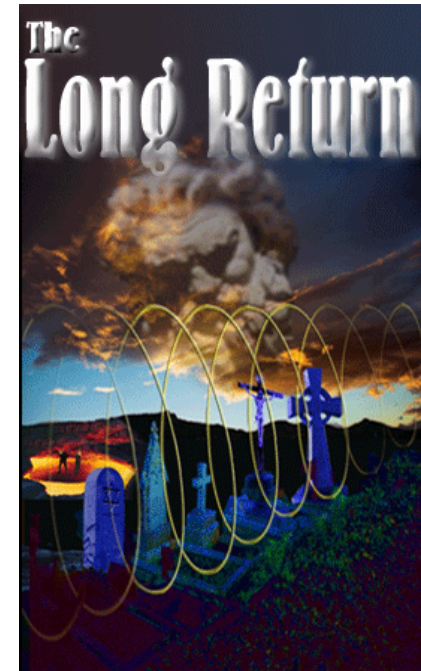
Imagine a book of prophecies starting with the 2003 war in Iraq, then shows concerns to be dealt with: from enemies of peace to threats from space, even the end of the Roman Church, and the identity of a returning messiah Enoch fore-

saw this a century before Jesus, including an upcoming war in Iran. The New Testament quotes the Book of Enoch many times, yet, as important as it was to content of the Bible then, its prophecies are almost unknown now.

This annotation uses an interlinear method, within the original text, to make it easier to read and understand. It reveals its overwhelming relationship to the End Time, and the messiah. The events shown in the earlier titles makes reading this one easier, by seeing what's coming. If it fails to amaze you, it means you missed crucial parts earlier in the series. This is one astonishing 'sleeper' and set of prophecies, not included in any religion's canon. It will interest all believers, particularly 'People of the Book'.

This annotation reveals the returned messiah and caps the longest running mystery known to humankind. A mystery that began with Abraham, was added to by notables who recorded their dreams, long ago. 280 pages, blue annotations, color images.

7. The Long Return



Who expects a messiah to bring peace? First you need to know who the enemies of peace are. We find much about him, his city, his name, his future wives, who he's a descendant of, his children, plus other bits of information. How did he get here? Same way we all 'arrive'. Can we recognize him and not make a big deal out of it, or as Enoch suggests

we acknowledge him by simply 'raising our eyebrows' (awareness)? We can learn about our next life after this life. Do you know how our 'life hereafter' is shown to us? The return process was taught long ago. Knowing when and where it will occur next is included too. Many concerns exist to be dealt with, including the appearance of the Promised Land. It isn't Israel.
